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


About us




Traditional Values

Kindergarten

Our nurturing, encouraging and challenging environment is an ideal place for your children to grow physically, socially, emotionally and cognitively.

In our Kindergarten classes, we utilize all our resources and educational knowledge to provide our students with a great head start. Inspired by the Early Years Foundation Stage Curriculum and the International Early Years Curriculum, our teachers introduce a variety of problem-solving activities to the students, designed to help them develop critical thinking skills and enhance their curiosity about the world around them. While safety is paramount, we want to create a nurturing environment to encourage our students to take on tasks and challenges that push them beyond their comfort zone.

Our Secondary students (Grades 6-12) are exposed to a variety of learning strategies to prepare them to become independent thinkers, to understand and to question the cause of things.



Computing in education

The world is changing rapidly integrating technology ingeniously into everyday life. Part of our goal is to bring clarity and perspective to our students to enable them to understand and experience how new computer software, hardware and infrastructures are changing the ways of classroom learning, thought process and innovation.

Our staff introduce creative teaching methods and techniques that support our students in developing 21st century skills and knowledge. Through our Apple iMAC and Windows laboratories, the students learn to write programs, develop applications, solve algorithms, edit videos and create artwork.

Performing arts gives the students a platform to engage the mind and body and encourages teamwork, creative thinking, verbal and non-verbal ways of communication giving students an opportunity to discover their own voice.

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How to apply to HASIS?

Step1:

Step 2:

Complete all application documents

Fill out all the admission forms and collate all requested documents (please refer to Admission Policy and Procedure Documents for the checklist).

Step 3:

Submit all application documents

Submit the application form and all other relevant documents to the HASIS registrar in person or via email to registrar@hasis.om

Step 4:

Placement testing

An interview and entrance assessment test will be scheduled. The parent will be notified of the same via email and / or phone.

Step 5:

Application review and acceptance

If your child has been successful, an offer letter will be made and a formal acceptance letter will be sent to the parents by the registrar for final signature. This must be returned within 7 working days of the receipt of the offer letter. If the school does not receive the signed acceptance letter within 7 working days, the school cannot guarantee the place offered.

Step 6:

On-boarding formalities

Along with the signed acceptance letter, the parent should provide one of the following to secure the place:

- 1. Placement fee (as applicable)
- 2. Letter from the employer confirming that the full fee will be paid for by them (as per instructions from the school's registrar)
