Responsibilities:

2. Maintain daily communication with families of children in your care.
3. Report any suspected child abuse to owner or administrator.
4. Maintain confidentiality with information shared by owner, administration, teachers, staff and families.
5. Maintain all appropriate daily records.
6. Assess and record progress in all areas of growth for children in your care. This includes physical, cognitive, social and emotional growth.
7. Document incidents and accidents appropriately for the administrators' approval.
8. Arrange the classroom environment in accordance to program goals.
9. Take all Kids 'R' Kids required curriculum, safety and childcare trainings and obtain Kids 'R' Kids certificate.
10. Stay current on and meet all licensing regulations.

Preferred Qualifications:

1. Holds a minimum of a Bachelor's Degree.
2. Speak English as native language.
3. Working knowledge of the behaviors and developmental stages of infant/toddler/pre-school age children, typically gained by working two year or more in a school or preschool setting.
4. Knowledge of safety practices as they related to infant/toddler/preschool age children.
5. Good written and oral communications skills.
