

York English was started in 2003 with the aim of doing ESL differently than other schools in China. Here at York, the quality of the education matters. We aim to provide students with creative, engaging, and educational lessons that will allow them to develop their language skills.

Our commitment to education is translated into the high-level of support that we provide for our teachers and staff. From a supportive community that welcomes new teachers, to comprehensive initial training and on-going professional development, we are here to make sure that our teachers have the resources, training, and support to succeed in the classroom.

OUR SCHOOLS

York English began in 2003 in Fuzhou, Fujian province. We have six schools located in the downtown with over 75 full-time native-English speaking teachers and over 3,500 students.

In 2017 we are opening schools for the first time in Shenzhen, Guangdong province.

OUR TEACHING

CLASS

What do all classes at York have in common? They are active, engaging, full of language production, and of, course, are educational. Whether you are using songs, chants or activities to get your students excited about the lesson, we strive to make learning memorable and fun!

COURSES

We have three levels that students are divided into based on their age: Kinder, Junior and Senior. Within each of these levels students are divided into classes based on their English understanding ensuring that all our students are of an even ability.

STUDENTS

That's right, **your** students. Here at York all of classes are taught by our international teachers, meaning that when you join us you are given your own classes and students, allowing you to develop a strong rapport with them.

Geting to know your students is made easier with our small class sizes as well, which allows you the time to give each students the support they require.



CURRICULUM

TEACHING TEAM

Whether you are brand new to ESL or have been doing it for a few years, everyone needs a bit of help from time to time. Here at York you will have lots of it, from your Academic Coordinator or Senior Teacher to your fellow teachers sitting all around you, there are lots of people ready and willing to share their ideas and experiences.

For each class you will have a Teaching Assistant ready to help you out. Whether they are acting as a second pair of eyes and ears in the class, helping to monitor students during activities, or providing a timely translation, your TA is a valulable part of the teaching team.

We developed a safety net system to keep parents informed of their childs progress. Progress reports are given throughout courses and TA's relay the information to the parents by phone calls. If a student is falling behind we offer restudy opportunities outside class to bring them up to speed.

2. OBSERVATIONS

Watching our teachers in action will give you hands-on experiences of the concepts in our training programme.

3. Q&A SESSION

If questions ever arise, regular catch-ups with your Academic Coordinator and Senior Teachers will give you plenty of opportunities to ask questions and get personalised support

4. TEAM TEACHING

Your first team-teaching experience at York will be done with an experienced teacher there to help guide you through it, providing encouragement and advice.

5. PRACTICE CLASSES

Once you have done teamteaching a few times you'll be ready for a practice class. Try out what you have learned in a low-pressure environment.

6. THE TAKE OVER

You are ready to take your own classes but rather than just tossing you in, sink or swim, we aim to stagger your class load, giving you more time for planning and reflection in the beginning and increasing your class load as your confidence and experience grows.



FURTHER TRAINING

WEEKLY **TEAM MEETINGS**

Each week on Friday the Academic Coordinators conduct a team meeting. These are designed to keep you informed about what's going on at York and to take feedback from staff.

TRAINING WORKSHOPS

Once a month training workshops are conducted by either the Senior Teacher or the Academic Coordinator. These are aimed to give new ideas when teaching different kinds of lessons.

TRAINING DAYS

Once or twice a year all international teachers will come together for a full day of training. These introduce dozens of activities and explain how to do them. There's also team building opportunities and a

ACTIVITY EXCHANGES

Once a month after the weekly team meeting teachers get to show off their favourite activities they have used that month.

OBSERVATIONS & FEEDBACK

A couple of times each quarter teachers will recieve an observation to help them find areas in which they can improve on. The feedback is always constructive and useful and gives you practical ideas on how to

PEER OBSERVATIONS

Peer observations provide a valuable opportunity for you to watch your fellow teachers in action. Sharing ideas and experiences are a big part of the York experience.

TEACHER CHALLENGES

Posted around the teacher's office are voluntary challenges that give experienced teachers a chance to push themselves and to get to the next level.

TEAM PLANNING

Team planning gives teachers a chance to brainstorm ideas for their classes together. This is a good opportunity to learn new activities, teaching methods and ways to conduct classes.

GIVING SOMETHING BACK Schools are a part of the community. They are a place for people to share ideas and grow. What we do as a school isn't just confined to the walls of our classroom.

Our work at York English means helping others and engaging with the local public schools. This could mean teaching a half-hour class once a month to students who don't get the chance to meet international teachers or it could be raising money to donate English books to poor rural communities.


3. TRAVEL

CITY

Located on China's southeastern coast, Fuzhou, the capital of Fujian province, is a 2,000 year-old city with a rich cultural heritage and beautiful scenery.

Fuzhou is surrounded by mountains and offers a variety of beautiful parks meaning that it is easy to get out of the city and into nature.

All this greenery means that Fuzhou is one of the cleanest cities in China, boasting some of the best air quality.

Fuzhou is a rapidly developing city but unlike most of China's Eastern coast this development has only begin in the last 15 years of so. This makes Fuzhou an ideal place to experience true China as many of its original buildings and traditions are still intact.

FOOD

Min Cuisine is one of the eight major cuisines of China. It has its own unique style that has evolved over a long time. Expect lots of seafood, sweet 'n' sour, spicy flavoursand lots of fresh vegetables.

HIGH-SPEED TRAIN

Fuzhou is quite centralized in China. This makes it incredibly easy to get to other cities such as Hong Kong, Shanghai and Beijing. It's also very affordable. So the last thing you need to worry about when traveling in China is the time or cost it takes to get to your destination.


Apartments are fully furnished with western toilets
