We are a private English Language training school based in Canada and operating in Chenzhou, Hunan Province in China.

Chenzhou is a large and beautiful city of 4.5 million people. It is surrounded by mountains, trees and parkland and the air is clean. The weather is predominantly warm and humid.

Chenzhou is just one and a half hours away from Guangzhou and 2 hours away by high speed train from Shenzhen on the border with Hong Kong.

Our school started in Chenzhou a year ago. We have a very happy team here and are now looking for a full-time kindergarten teacher, a native English speaker who loves working with little children and who is curious and interested about spending time in this part of China.

Employment Terms

We will pay a monthly salary into your personal bank account. If necessary, you can draw it out in China using your ATM card. On top of your salary, we will pay for your return

airfares, an apartment in Chenzhou, and provide you with an expense allowance every month as well as costs and assistance for your visa. There is also a bonus scheme depending upon your contract duration.

Salary: Between \$2000-\$3000 per month

Schedule

You will be teaching for 5 days per week: Wednesday through Sunday. Monday and Tuesday will be your days off.

Part of the time you will be teaching lessons in a Kindergarten / Preschool. These will involve teaching conversational English using songs, games and activities with the children. Some preparation will be necessary for these lessons.

On Saturday & Sunday you will be teaching English classes to children aged 5-10 years. The lesson plans are online and fully digital and provide games, stories and songs to be used in the class.

Besides two days off per week, you will enjoy holiday breaks for all Chinese national holidays.

Qualifications

To work as a kindergarten teacher in China, you will need to be physically fit, active and healthy.

You should be a native English speaker. You do not need to speak Chinese. You will have a teaching assistant to help you in class.

You should have some higher education: a University or College degree, diploma or teaching qualification.

Experience teaching little kids and a happy, fun loving nature.
